Required Admissions Materials

Application Deadline (Fall 2014): May 15, 2014

- 1. Submit application and application fee for Certificate Program.
- 2. Mail in OFFICIAL university transcripts (students must have a 2.75 GPA).
- 3. Meet one of the following English Language Requirements:
 - Meet the current score requirements on the Test of English as a Foreign Language (TOEFL) -525 (Paper Based Exam) or 65 Internet Based Exam (with minimum of 14 in sections). Only official test scores received directly from the testing authority (ETS) will be considered valid (www.ets.org).
 - Pass the IELTS test (International English Language Testing System) with a minimum score of 6.0 (www.ielts.org).
 - Pass the iTEP (International Test of English Proficiency) with a score of 5.0.
 - Or meet other language requirement options as outlined by International Admissions.
- 4. Show financial (tuition and living expenses) support for one academic year:
 - An original bank statement in your name, which indicates the amount of funds available.
 - An original bank statement in your guarantor's name (sponsor or parent) that indicates the amount available accompanied by a letter of confirmation from the guarantor of his or her intention to provide support. The bank statement MUST indicate a minimum amount held in the account, on bank stationary with a telephone, FAX number and street address.
 - Or submit other finiancial documents as outlined by International Admissions.
